Seeking various types of artists to interpret the natural and garden environment: watercolor, oils, acrylics, photography, sculpture, etc. Artists will be stationed around the grounds during the event. Bring your easel and supplies and create art based on the arboretum and its many plants during the course of the event. As you work, speak with visitors about your technique and sell your pieces, if desired.

Rules for participation:

- Artists must register by September 1, 2017. Artists that have been accepted will be contacted by email the following week.
- By Friday, September 15th, artists must sign a hold harmless agreement and submit payment by cash or check made out to "MCPC."
- If applicable, artists must supply a photo of how they will display their artwork for sale by September 15.
- Spaces will be either 6'x6' or 6'x4' and will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
- Artists must have someone at their station at all times from 10am-3pm and are required to interact with visitors, explaining their art and techniques throughout the event.
- It is recommended that artists offer works in a variety of price ranges, such as cards, small pieces, and large pieces.
