Removal of Spring show: Tues., June 4th, 2024 from 12PM-2:00PM. Alternatively, as we have done in past years, you may leave your work up until September as we have NO separate Summer show.

Where: Chatham Township Municipal Building, 58 Meyersville Road **Entry Fee & Procedure**

- \$10 for members entering up to 4 pieces of artwork in the show.
- Members are responsible for submitting entry forms & checks. Additional forms can be found on our web site: artleagueofthechathams.org.

- Sales: If one of your pieces sells during the exhibit & is taken off the
 wall, please try to replace it with something close to the same size and
 price ASAP.

Conditions:

- > When applying labels to the front and back of artwork, PLEASE use as little tape as possible. Too much tape often leaves a gloppy residue on the glass and is very difficult to remove. Attach the front label lightly in the lower right corner. Use a minimum amount of tape.
- ➢ Paintings must be framed & wired in a professional manner. NO SAW TEETH please. Plexiglas should be used for large paintings & paintings in metal frames. Sculptors and other non-hanging art must supply their own stand.
- > Wet paintings, pieces that are too heavy, nudes, or pieces that might be considered objectionable to the public should be reviewed by exhibit chair (Celeste Fondaco).
- Sales tax should be incorporated into your price & is the artist's responsibility.

Liability: Artwork will be handled with care, but neither the Township of Chatham nor Art League of the Chathams will be responsible for any loss or damage, no matter how it may be caused. Also, the Art League cannot be responsible for work left at the end of the exhibit. Your entry to this exhibit acknowledges your understanding & agreement with the above terms.

Hanging Guidelines

Professional hanging procedures are very important to keeping the quality of the Art League of the Chathams high. Below are some things to keep in mind when getting ready for an exhibit.

- When putting the wire on the back of paintings, wire them 1/3 of the way from the top. This makes all the paintings hang at the same angle against the wall.
- Make sure the ends of wire are not sticking out. It is suggested that you use tape around the wire ends to keep accidents from happening.
- Use acid free materials to back your watercolors.
- Make sure screw eyes are in the frame securely.
- All works on canvas (oil, acrylic, etc.) need to be framed unless the edges are finished. Staples should not show.
- All art work should be dry.
- Mats should be clean and secure.
- Frames need to be in good condition.
- Please use minimal tape to adhere name tags to work.

Adhering to these guidelines will help prevent accidents or damage to your work. And once again, neither the Township of Chatham nor the Art League of the Chathams will be responsible for any loss or damage, no matter how it may occur.
